



Code of Conduct – Coaches

Lochend Football Academy is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members. The club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the club should always show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore, coaches are always encouraged to be open and to share any concerns or complaints that they have about any aspect of the club with the committee and/or the Health & Wellbeing Officer.

As a coach of Lochend Football Academy, you are expected to abide by the following code of conduct:

- Respect every player including the opposition
- Be conscious of the safety of every player
- Be fair with the playing time for each player
- Be aware and follow the development policy and guidelines of the club
- Show good behaviour and appearance
- Be respectful of all decisions made by match officials
- Never use inappropriate or bad language
- Abide by the medical advice concerning an injured player
- Be aware of any medical conditions that any player has – this can be accessed on the shared drive
- Ensure all players are aware of training times and football matches
- Attend any relevant training deemed appropriate by the clubs committee and keep up to date with the latest, drills, techniques, first aid, PVGs & SYFA requirements
