

Dundee Ducks Fire Evacuation

Safety

- Make yourself aware of all EXITS. Doors are fitted with panic bars
- Ensure both fire escape shutters are open to allow fire exit doors to open
- Ensure the Fire Hydrant is clear of parked cars, and a cone is in place to prevent parking
- Ensure all "Keep Clear" areas are clear of all furniture, bins, goals etc
- Ensure timekeepers bench have a clear passageway to both fire escapes
Clear away all training aids, stools, rubbish, goals etc
- Ensure a clear walkway around the rink
- Ensure pad exit doors are free to open fully
- Ensure all fire exit signs are in place

EXIT SIGNS REMAIN LIT AT ALL TIMES

Fire extinguishers are located by each of the emergency exits.

If you discover a fire

Immediately push the center of a red manual call point, located next to all exits, which will activate the alarm. Inform everyone that there is a fire and that they are to evacuate the building immediately.

You Must Dial 999 to call the Fire & Emergency Service – even if the fire appears to be minor. Give the address as: **Dundee Ducks, Unit 8 Manhattan Works, 51 Dundonald Street, Dundee, DD3 7PY**

On hearing the Fire Alarm

As you leave the building close all internal doors, if safe to do so.

Leave the building from any of the available fire exits and make your way to the pavement area by the car park. Assembly point 1.

When all persons can be accounted for, request drivers of their vehicles to remove their cars if it is safe to do so, leaving the area in front and to the side of the Sports Hall free for the Fire & Emergency Service.

If safe to do so, send somebody round to Showcase the Street to inform their duty manager of the situation or phone 01382 699623

USE THE NEAREST EXIT DO NOT STOP TO COLLECT PERSONAL BELONGINGS
DO NOT RE-ENTER THE BUILDING UNLESS AUTHORISED BY THE FIRE OFFICER

When dealing with Fire

If a person's clothing is on fire, wrap a blanket, rug or similar article closely around them and lay them on the ground to prevent flames reaching the head. If electrical appliances are involved, switch off the current before dealing with the fire.

Please read this notice carefully and ensure that you are familiar with the fire procedure, the location of all fire extinguishers and all exit routes.

Ensure that all exit routes are always clear from obstruction
