When watching football, I will:

- Celebrate good play from both sides.
- Respect the referee and coaches and allow them to do their job, encouraging players to do the same.
- Stay behind the touchline, within the designated spectator areas.
- Offer encouragement to players if mistakes are made.
- Not use offensive, abusive or insulting language and report it if you hear this.
- Support coaches and children in training, matches, keeping subs up to date.
- Lead by example

What will happen if I don't follow these codes:

- These codes are written to keep everybody safe.
- If I don't follow the codes, I could:
 - Be asked to leave part of or all of a game.
 - Be asked to speak to somebody from the club's committee.
 - Miss a number of games.
 - Be asked to leave the club.

Who I can speak to:

- If you feel unhappy or worried about something, speak to your child's coach.
- If your concern continues, please speak to the club Welfare Officer, Lisa Adamson, or any member of the club committee. They will spend time to talk through the situation with you and investigate fully if necessary.
