As a coach/assistant, I will:

Always show respect to everyone involved.

Adhere to the rules, encouraging fair play.

Respect the referee's decision, encouraging players to do the same. Challenge decisions calmly and at an appropriate time.

Never enter the field of play without the referee's permission.

Not use offensive, abusive or insulting language and report it if you hear this.

Be gracious, regardless of the score.

Respect the facilities, home or away.

Keep qualifications and DBS in date.

Ask for help or support if I need this.

Working with players, I will:

Ensure the well-being, safety and enjoyment of all players is the main priority.

Never tolerate any form of bullying

Ensure activities are suited based on the players' ability and age.

Work with others for each player's best interests.

What will happen if I don't follow these codes:

These codes are written to keep everybody safe.

If I don't follow the codes, I could:

Forfeit points for my child's team.

Be asked to leave part of or all of a game.

Be asked to speak to a member of the club's committee.

Miss a number of games.

Be suspended by the County FA.

Be asked to leave the club.

They will spend time to talk through the situation with you and investigate fully if necessary.
