

East Fife Community Football Club Volunteer Code of Conduct

All volunteers must adhere to all guidelines laid down by governing bodies.

Volunteers must place the well-being and safety of each player above all other considerations, including winning.

Volunteers must show respect to others involved in the game including your club's players, your club's officials, your opposition's players, your opposition club's officials, match officials, all parents and supporters.

Volunteers must always promote the positive aspects of football and never participate in or condone violations of the Laws of the Game or relevant SYFA rules and regulations or the use of prohibited substances or techniques.

Volunteers must ensure that all activities are appropriate for the age, maturity, experience and ability of players.

Volunteers should, at the outset, clarify with the players (and where appropriate, their parents) exactly what is expected of them and also what they are entitled to expect from their club.

Volunteers must always be honest with players, parents, guardians and officials.

Volunteers must develop an appropriate working relationship with each player based on mutual trust and respect.

Volunteers must not exert undue influence to obtain personal benefit or reward.

Volunteers must encourage and guide players to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance.

Volunteers must consistently display high standards of behaviour and appearance.

Volunteers must never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour.



Volunteers must promote and encourage, particularly to young players, the importance of a healthy lifestyle and diet.

Volunteers must maintain a high level of confidentiality when dealing with club business.

Volunteers must adhere to the terms of the Clubs Policy on Anti-Discrimination.
