We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game.

Deveronvale CFC's Code of Conduct has been created to ensure football can be enjoyed in a safe, positive environment.

Remember children's football is a time for them to develop their technical, physical, tactical and social skills. Winning isn't everything.

Play your Part and observe Deveronvale CFC's Code of Conduct for Spectators and Parents/Carers at all times.

I WILL:

- Applaud effort and good play as well as success
- Always respect the decision of the match official
- Remain outside the field of play and within the Designated Spectators Area (where provided)
- Let the coach do their job and do not confuse the players by telling them what to do
- Encourage the players to respect the opposition, referee and match officials
- Avoid criticising a player for making a mistake – mistakes are part of learning

- Avoid placing undue pressure on players away from training/matches
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour
- Never promote/support unsporting behaviour
- Never approach/confront a referee, match official or coach
- Respect Deveronvale CFC's Image policy and refrain from taking photographs or videos during matches and training

I understand that if I do not follow the code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by Deveronvale FC:

I MAY BE:

- Officially warned about my conduct by a Club Official
- Required to meet with a Club Representative
- Obligated to leave the match venue by the club representative
- Requested by the Club not to attend future games
- Suspended or requested to leave the Club along with any dependants
