## St Cadoc's Youth Club Policies

Below are the policies administered by St Cadoc's youth club, all individuals involved in the youth club must adhere to them.

## **Coaches Charter**

As Coaches we endeavour to achieve the following for all St Cadoc's players:

- We will respect the rights dignity and worth of every player and treat everyone equally within the context of the football club.
- We will always promote the positive aspects of football and the ethos of the youth club, including fair play.
- We will place the well being and safety of the player above the development of performance.
- We will follow all guidelines laid down by the sports governing body.
- We will ensure that the selection policy in operation within teams is consistent with the ethos of the Youth Club and is fully understood by players and parents.
- We will develop an appropriate working relationship with players, especially young children, based on mutual trust and respect. We will not exert undue influence to obtain personal benefit or reward.
- We will encourage and guide players to accept responsibility for their own behaviour.
- We will endeavour to gain nationally recognised governing body coaching qualifications appropriate to the age group we are involved with.
- We will ensure that the activities we direct or advocate are appropriate for the age, maturity, experience and ability of the individual player.
- We will at the outset clarify with the players, and their parents, exactly what is expected of them. (See also the Players Charter).
- We will consistently display high standards of behaviour and appearance.
- We will supply a minimum of 1/2 coaches/volunteers, preferably 3 if possible for all training and matches, 1 of which will be a First Aider.
