- Win or lose with dignity, shake hands with the opposing team and the referee at the end of every game.
- Treat all players as you would wish to be treated yourself fairly
- Co-operate with club officials, referees and your team mates
- Always respect the match officials decisions
- Control your temper verbal abuse of officials and abusing other players doesn't help you enjoy or win any games.
- Don't use ugly remarks based on race, religion, gender or ability you'll let down your team mates and the club if you do and many such comments are actually now illegal.
- Play for your own enjoyment
- Remember we all make mistakes

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any / all of the following actions may be taken by my club or the League Management Committee.

- Be required to apologise to team-mates, the other team, referee or team manager;
- Receive a warning from the coach;
- Receive a written warning from the League Management Committee;
- Be dropped or substituted;
- Be suspended from training;
- Not be selected for the team;
- Be required to serve a suspension.
