



PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

The Players must abide by the Laws of the Game, the Rules of Scottish FA and Women's Football, the Affiliated Youth League's and the rules of any competition in which they participate.

- It is each player's responsibility to behave appropriately while representing Rossvale Football Club. Players shall not use foul, abuse or offensive language or gestures.
- It is the responsibility of players to respect the other players in the team and other teams, players will not unfairly criticise or belittle any player from any club.
- It is the responsibility of each player to look after their own kit and personal items.
- Every player must attend training every week unless they have a valid reason. A club official must be informed on or before the day that the player(s) intends to miss. This must not become a regular occurrence.
- If you have been given a time to meet you must be there on time, lateness disrupts team preparation.
- It is the player's and/ or parent/ guardian's responsibility to manage injuries or illness and report them in order to prevent further damage occurring.
- Everyone is expected to support the club's committee and their decisions.
- Discipline must be adhered to on the park, players must accept success, failure, victory or defeat with good grace.

Any breach of any provision of these Code of Conducts by a player shall constitute a breach of the Rossvale FC rules and shall be dealt with appropriately by the club committee.
